AMENDED ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On January 9, 2020, the Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules (MOAHR) issued an Order of Dismissal in the above-referenced matter due to the failure of Petitioner Sherrie Stewart to participate in the hearing scheduled on January 8, 2019.
