On March 3, 2020, the Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules (MOAHR) received your correspondence appealing the Order of Dismissal issued by Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) [REDACTED] in MOAHR docket number 19-013609. In the Order of Dismissal (Order) issued on February 24, 2020, ALJ [REDACTED] dismissed your hearing request as untimely. The Order provided that an appeal of the dismissal could be made to the circuit court. Because there was no hearing decision in this matter, at this time any appeal that you wish to take of the Order must be to circuit court, as provided in the "Notice of Appeal" on page 2 of the Order. If the Department of Health and Human Services has taken any new actions in your case and you dispute this action, you may submit a hearing request with the Department's local office in accordance with Department policy.
