**ORDER OF DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO
WITHDRAWAL OF HEARING REQUEST AT HEARING**


This matter is before the Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules upon Petitioner's request for hearing made pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37, and Titles 7, 42, and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which govern the administrative hearing and appeal process. After due notice, a telephone hearing was commenced on December 19, 2019, from Detroit, Michigan. Petitioner represented herself. The Department of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by [REDACTED] Assistance Payments Supervisor, and [REDACTED], Eligibility Specialist.

The hearing was requested to dispute the Department's action taken with respect to the Food Assistance Program (FAP) and Medical Assistance (MA) program benefits. Shortly after commencement of the hearing, Petitioner testified that she now understood that she is entitled to \$61.00 per month in FAP benefits as long as her daughter is under 22 years of age and resides in the home. The Department confirmed that Petitioner's MA benefits are active and that there has been no interruption in coverage. As such, Petitioner stated did not wish to proceed with the hearing. The Request for Hearing was withdrawn. The Department agreed to the dismissal of the hearing request.

Pursuant to the withdrawal of the hearing request filed in this matter, the Request for Hearing is, hereby, **DISMISSED**.
