AMENDED HEARING DECISION

Following Petitioner's request for a hearing, this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and 400.37; 42 CFR 431.200 to 431.250. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on February 20, 2019 from Lansing, Michigan. Petitioner personally appeared and testified. The Department of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by Eligibility Specialist Veronica Bracy.

At the conclusion of the hearing, a Hearing Decision was issued by Administrative Law Judge Vicki L. Armstrong and mailed on March 22, 2019, which is hereby **AMENDED** to correct the date the Department shall review Petitioner's medical condition.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the competent, material, and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds as material fact:

1. All Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained in the original Hearing Decision dated March 22, 2019, remain unchanged and are incorporated herein by reference.

DECISION AND ORDER


Accordingly, the Department's determination is REVERSED.

THE DEPARTMENT IS ORDERED TO INITIATE THE FOLLOWING, IN ACCORDANCE WITH DEPARTMENT POLICY AND CONSISTENT WITH THIS HEARING DECISION, WITHIN 10 DAYS OF THE DATE THE ORDER WAS ISSUED:

1. The Department shall process Petitioner's [REDACTED] SDA application, and shall award him all the benefits he may be entitled to receive, as long as he meets the remaining financial and non-financial eligibility factors.
2. The Department shall review Petitioner's medical condition for improvement in March 2020, unless his Social Security Administration disability status is approved by that time.
3. The Department shall obtain updated medical evidence from Petitioner's treating physicians, physical therapists, pain clinic notes, etc. regarding his continued treatment, progress and prognosis at review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
