ORDER GRANTING ADJOURNMENT

Upon the request for a hearing by the Department of Health and Human Services (Department), this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9, and in accordance with Titles 7, 42 and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulation (CFR), particularly 7 CFR 273.16, 42 CFR 431.230(b), and 45 CFR 235.110, and with Mich Admin Code, R 400.3130 and 400.3178. After due notice, a telephone hearing was commenced on December 4, 2019, from Detroit, Michigan. The Department was represented by [REDACTED] Regulation Agent of the Office of Inspector General (OIG).

At the start of the hearing, [REDACTED] indicated that prior to the date of the hearing, he discovered that Respondent had applied for benefits approximately six weeks prior to the date of the hearing. The application contained the following updated address: 26228 Ohio, Novi, MI 48374. The Notice of Hearing was not sent to the Respondent at that address. Therefore, it is unclear if Respondent received notice of the hearing. The Department did not object to an adjournment to allow proper notice to Petitioner. The undersigned Administrative Law Judge, having found good cause exists to adjourn the hearing in this matter,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that this hearing is hereby **ADJOURNED** and will be rescheduled for hearing with notice provided to parties in accordance with applicable law and policy.
