HEARING DECISION

Following Petitioner's request for a hearing, this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and 400.37; 7 CFR 273.15 to 273.18; 42 CFR 431.200 to 431.250; 45 CFR 99.1 to 99.33; and 45 CFR 205.10. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on January 30, 2020, from Lansing, Michigan. Petitioner represented himself land his mother testified on his behalf. The Department of Health and Human Services was represented by Valarie Foley.

<u>ISSUE</u>

Did the Department of Health and Human Services (Department) properly determine Petitioner's eligibility for State Supplemental Security Income (SSP) benefits?

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the competent, material, and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds as material fact:

- 1. The Department's representative testified that Petitioner's federal Supplemental Security Income (SSI) were terminated by the Social Security Administration.
- 2. On November 21, 2019, the Department notified Petitioner that his Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits had been cancelled. Exhibit A, p 1.
- 3. On the latest the Department received Petitioner's request for a hearing protesting the denial of State Supplemental Security Income (SSP) benefits. Exhibit A, pp 1-2.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Department policies are contained in the Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM), Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Eligibility Manual (BEM), Department of Health and Human Services Reference Tables Manual (RFT), and Department of Health and Human Services Emergency Relief Manual (ERM).

The State SSI Payments (SSP) program is established by 20 CFR 416.2001-.2099 and the Social Security Act, 42 USC 1382e. The Department administers the program pursuant to MCL 400.10.

Petitioner was a recipient of Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits from the Social Security Administration, a federal agency. When Petitioner's SSI benefits closed, and Petitioner did not dispute that those benefits closed, Petitioner was no longer eligible for SSP benefits from the state of Michigan. Therefore, on November 21, 2019, the Department notified Petitioner that his SSP benefits would close.

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and for the reasons stated on the record, if any, finds that the Department acted in accordance with Department policy when it closed Petitioner's State Supplemental Security Income (SSP).

DECISION AND ORDER

Accordingly, the Department's decision is AFFIRMED.
