# HEARING DECISION

Upon the request for a hearing by the Department of Health and Human Services (Department), this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9, and in accordance with Titles 7, 42 and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulation (CFR), particularly 7 CFR 273.16, 42 CFR 431.230(b), and 45 CFR 235.110, and with Mich Admin Code, R 400.3130 and 400.3178. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on January 23, 2020, from Lansing, Michigan. The Department was represented by April Kentner, Recoupment Specialist from the Department of Health and Human Services. The Respondent was represented by herself.

#### <u>ISSUE</u>

Did Respondent receive an over-issuance (OI) of the Food Assistance Program (FAP) due to Client error?

## FINDINGS OF FACT

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the competent, material, and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds as material fact:

- 1. Respondent was a recipient of FAP benefits from the Department.
- 2. The Department alleges Respondent received a FAP OI during the period November 1, 2014, through June 30, 2015, due to Respondent's error.
- 3. The Department alleges that Respondent received \$2,850.00 FAP OI that is still due and owing to the Department.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Department policies are contained in the Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM), Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Eligibility Manual (BEM), and Department of Health and Human Services Reference Tables Manual (RFT).

The Food Assistance Program (FAP) [formerly known as the Food Stamp program] is established by the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008, as amended, 7 USC 2011 to 2036a and is implemented by the federal regulations contained in 7 CFR 273. The Department (formerly known as the Department of Human Services) administers FAP pursuant to MCL 400.10, the Social Welfare Act, MCL 400.1-.119b, and Mich Admin Code, R 400.3001 to .3015.

Additionally, Respondent failed to report to the Department her earned employment income at Employbridge in a timely manner. As a result, Respondent received a FAP OI during the period November 1, 2014, through June 30, 2015, due to Respondent's error. Respondent received \$2,850.00 FAP OI that is still due and owing to the Department. Department Exhibit 1, pgs. 2-78. BAM 105, 110, 115, 220, 700, 715, and 725. BEM 500, 501, 503, and 550.

## DECISION AND ORDER

The Administrative Law Judge, based upon the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, finds that the Department **did** establish a FAP benefit OI to Respondent totaling \$2,850.00.

Accordingly, the Department is **AFFIRMED**.

The Department is ORDERED to initiate collection procedures for a \$2,850.00 FAP OI in accordance with Department policy.
