On 2021, the Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules (MOAHR) received your faxed letter expressing concerns about the local Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) office's failure to comply with the order in ALJ John Markey's 2020 Hearing Decision concerning your Child Development and Care (CDC) benefits issued under MOAHR docket no. 20-000224.

Once the ALJ issues a hearing decision, MOAHR no longer has any authority to enforce MDHHS's implementation of the decision. However, from your letter, it appears that MDHHS has processed the redetermination in your CDC case and issued a *new* decision. Because MDHHS appears to have taken a new action, if you dispute the outcome of this decision, you will have to request a new hearing.
