**ORDER OF DISMISSAL PURSUANT TO  
WITHDRAWAL OF HEARING REQUEST AT HEARING**

This matter is before the Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules upon Petitioner’s request for hearing made pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37, and Titles 7, 42, and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which govern the administrative hearing and appeal process. After due notice, a telephone hearing commenced on March 5, 2024. Anies Abulebdeh, the Petitioner, appeared on his own behalf. The Department of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by Lori Turner, Eligibility Specialist (ES).

The hearing was requested to dispute the Department’s action taken with respect to Medical Assistance program (MA) benefits, specifically the Medicare Savings Program (MSP). Shortly after commencement of the hearing, the Department confirmed that Petitioner has been approved for the MSP starting November 1, 2023. Accordingly, Petitioner withdrew the hearing request on the record. The Department agreed to the dismissal of the hearing request.

Pursuant to the withdrawal of the hearing request filed in this matter, the Request for Hearing is, hereby, **DISMISSED**.
