ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Following Petitioner’s request for a hearing, this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and 400.37; 7 CFR 273.15 to 273.18; 42 CFR 431.200 to 431.250; 42 CFR 438.400 to 438.424; 45 CFR 99.1 to 99.33; and 45 CFR 205.10; and Mich Admin Code, R 792.11002. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on April 9, 2024, from Lansing, Michigan. The Department of Health and Human Services (Department) was represented by Colleen McKenna, Assistance Payments Worker.

Lance White, the Petitioner, called into the conference line for the hearing but would not remain on the line to go on the record for this case. Petitioner asserted that he did not request the hearing and indicated that a different local Department office has resolved everything.


The hearing proceeding was initiated by a hearing request from Petitioner submitted to the Midland County Department office on February [REDACTED] 2024 stating “I request a hearing. I sent this in as I was told. I [D]id everything as I was told” signed by Lance White.

However, Petitioner declined to go on the record for this case and indicated everything has been resolved.

Accordingly, Petitioner’s hearing request is, therefore, **DISMISSED**.
