HEARING DECISION

Following Petitioner's request for a hearing, this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and 400.37; 7 CFR 273.15 to 273.18; 42 CFR 431.200 to 431.250; 45 CFR 99.1 to 99.33; and 45 CFR 205.10. After due notice, a telephone hearing was held on November 7, 2023, from Lansing, Michigan. Petitioner represented herself. The Department was represented by Verenie Davis and Kelli Greer.

ISSUE

Did the Department of Health and Human Services (Department) properly close Petitioner's Medical Assistance (MA)?

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the competent, material, and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds as material fact:

1. On July [REDACTED] 2023, the Department sent Petitioner a Redetermination (DHS-1010) form with an August 4, 2023, due date in an effort to determine her eligibility for ongoing benefits. Exhibit A, p 5.
2. On September [REDACTED] 2023, the Department notified Petitioner that she was not eligible for Medical Assistance (MA) effective October 1, 2023. Exhibit A, p 15.
3. On September [REDACTED] 2023, the Department received Petitioner's request for a hearing protesting the closure of her Medical Assistance (MA). Exhibit A, p 4.
4. On September [REDACTED] 2023, the Department received a completed copy of Petitioner's Redetermination form that was dated September 27, 2023. Exhibit A, pp 20-26.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Department policies are contained in the Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM), Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Eligibility Manual (BEM), Department of Health and Human Services Reference Tables Manual (RFT), and Department of Health and Human Services Emergency Relief Manual (ERM).

The Medical Assistance (MA) program is established by Title XIX of the Social Security Act, 42 USC 1396 through 42 USC 1396w-5; 42 USC 1315; the Affordable Care Act of 2010, the collective term for the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, Pub. L. No. 111-148, as amended by the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010, Pub. L. No. 111-152; and 42 CFR 430.10 through 42 CFR 420.25. The Department administers the MA program pursuant to 42 CFR 435, MCL 400.10, and MCL 400.103 through MCL 400.112k of the Social Welfare Act, MCL 400.1 *et seq.*

Clients must cooperate with the local office in determining initial and ongoing eligibility and this includes the completion of necessary forms. Department of Human Services Bridges Assistance Manual (BAM) 105 (October 1, 2023), p 9.

Verification means documentation or other evidence to establish the accuracy of the client's verbal or written statements. Verification is usually required at application/redetermination and for a reported change affecting eligibility or benefit level when it is required by policy, required as a local office option, or information regarding an eligibility factor is unclear, inconsistent, incomplete, or contradictory. The Department uses documents, collateral contacts, or home calls to verify information. A collateral contact is a direct contact with a person, organization, or agency to verify information from the client. When documentation is not available, or clarification is needed, collateral contact may be necessary. Department of Human Services Bridges Assistance Manual (BAM) 130 (October 1, 2023), pp 1-10.

Petitioner was an ongoing recipient of MA benefits on July 5, 2023, when the Department initiated a routine review of her eligibility for ongoing benefits by sending her a Redetermination form with an August 4, 2023, due date. On September █████ 2023, the Department had not received the completed Redetermination form and it notified Petitioner that her eligibility for MA benefits would end on October 1, 2023.

Petitioner argued that she did return the Redetermination form but failed to offer any evidence that she returned that form in a timely manner.

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and for the reasons stated on the record, if any, finds that the Department acted in accordance with Department policy when it closed Petitioner's Medical Assistance (MA) benefits.


Petitioner returned the Redetermination form along with her request for a hearing and the Department granted Petitioner an extension to the redetermination process. Petitioner is

potentially eligible for ongoing benefits and the Department's representative testified that her eligibility for reinstatement was pending as of September 27, 2023.

DECISION AND ORDER

Accordingly, the Department's decision is AFFIRMED.
