ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the Michigan Office of Administrative Hearings and Rules (MOAHR) upon Petitioner’s request for hearing made pursuant to MCL 400.9 and MCL 400.37, and Titles 7, 42, and 45 of the Code of Federal Regulations, which govern the administrative hearing and appeal process.

A hearing was scheduled for March 13, 2024, at 9:50 a.m. pursuant to the February 6, 2024, request for an administrative hearing filed by Petitioner regarding Medical Assistance (MA) benefits.

The Department has received reliable information that Petitioner passed away on or around March 3, 2024.

Requests for a hearing must be made in writing and signed by an adult member of the eligible group of the clients authorized hearing representative. The appointment of an AHR must be made in writing. An AHR must be authorized or have made application through probate court before signing a hearing request for the client. Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM) 600 (February 1, 2024), p 2.

Since Petitioner’s death, she no longer exists as a legal entity and a representative must be appointed to represent her estate. Therefore, the Petitioner’s February 6, 2024, hearing request must be **DISMISSED**.
