ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On January 14, 2025, Petitioner Montoyya Sims requested a hearing to dispute public assistance benefits. As a result, a hearing was scheduled to be held on March 13, 2025. Public assistance hearings are held pursuant to MCL 400.9 and 400.37; 7 CFR 273.15 to 273.18; 42 CFR 431.200 to 431.250; 42 CFR 438.400 to 438.424; 45 CFR 99.1 to 99.33; 45 CFR 205.10; and Mich Admin Code, R 792.11002.

A hearing was held as scheduled on March 13, 2025, but it could not be completed within the scheduled amount of time, so it was continued. A continuance order and notice of continued hearing was issued to the parties on March 17, 2025, to notify the parties that the continued hearing was scheduled to be held at 9:50 a.m. on April 1, 2025.

Petitioner and Respondent both appeared for the continued hearing on April 1, 2025. Petitioner began to present her testimony, but Petitioner became disruptive and behaved in a manner that prevented the undersigned administrative law judge from conducting a fair and orderly hearing. Petitioner defied the undersigned administrative law judge's multiple attempts to restore order, so the undersigned administrative law judge dismissed Petitioner's hearing request pursuant to MCL 24.280(1)(d); Mich Admin Code, R 792.11005; and Mich Admin Code, R 792.10106(1)(c).
