HEARING DECISION

Following Petitioner's request for a hearing, this matter is before the undersigned Administrative Law Judge pursuant to MCL 400.9 and 400.37; 7 CFR 273.15 to 273.18; 42 CFR 431.200 to 431.250; 45 CFR 99.1 to 99.33; and 45 CFR 205.10; and Mich Admin Code, R 792.11002. After due notice, a hearing was held in person in Benton Harbor, Michigan. Petitioner appeared and was represented by her son [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS or Department) was represented by Krista Hailey, Hearing Facilitator. Department Exhibit 1, pp. 1-12 was received and admitted.

ISSUE

Did the Department properly determine Petitioner's Medical Assistance (MA) and Food Assistance Program (FAP) eligibility?

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the competent, material, and substantial evidence on the whole record, finds as material fact:

1. On November [REDACTED] 2024, a request for hearing was submitted on behalf of Petitioner by her son [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. Boxes were checked for MA, FAP, SER, SDA and other. (Ex. 1, p.6)
2. Petitioner had previously requested a hearing regarding "all programs" on September [REDACTED] 2025.
3. Petitioner did not appear at the October [REDACTED] 2025, hearing and the hearing was dismissed.
4. No actions have been taken on Petitioner's case since her last hearing request was dismissed.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Department policies are contained in the Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Administrative Manual (BAM), Department of Health and Human Services Bridges Eligibility Manual (BEM), Department of Health and Human Services Reference

Tables Manual (RFT), and Department of Health and Human Services Emergency Relief Manual (ERM).

The Food Assistance Program (FAP) [formerly known as the Food Stamp program] is established by the Food and Nutrition Act of 2008, as amended, 7 USC 2011 to 2036a and is implemented by the federal regulations contained in 7 CFR 273. The Department (formerly known as the Department of Human Services) administers FAP pursuant to MCL 400.10, the Social Welfare Act, MCL 400.1-.119b, and Mich Admin Code, R 400.3001-.3011.

The Medical Assistance (MA) program is established by Title XIX of the Social Security Act, 42 USC 1396-1396w-5; 42 USC 1315; the Affordable Care Act of 2010, the collective term for the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, Pub. L. No. 111-148, as amended by the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010, Pub. L. No. 111-152; and 42 CFR 430.10-.25. The Department (formerly known as the Department of Human Services) administers the MA program pursuant to 42 CFR 435, MCL 400.10, and MCL 400.105-.112k.

The State Disability Assistance (SDA) program is established by the Social Welfare Act, MCL 400.1-.119b. The Department of Health and Human Services (formerly known as the Department of Human Services) administers the SDA program pursuant to 42 CFR 435, MCL 400.10 and Mich Admin Code, R 400.3151-.3180.

The State Emergency Relief (SER) program is established by the Social Welfare Act, MCL 400.1-.119b. The SER program is administered by the Department (formerly known as the Department of Human Services) pursuant to MCL 400.10 and Mich Admin Code, R 400.7001-.7049.

In this case, Petitioner had previously requested a hearing regarding “all programs” on September █ 2025. Petitioner did not appear at the October █ 2025, hearing and the hearing was dismissed. No actions have been taken on Petitioner’s case since her last hearing request was dismissed. Petitioner could not articulate at hearing what Department action she was disputing.

DECISION AND ORDER

The Administrative Law Judge, based on the above Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and for the reasons stated on the record, if any, finds that the Department acted in accordance with Department policy when it determined Petitioner's eligibility for FAP and MA.

Accordingly, the Department's decision is **AFFIRMED**.
