R 325.971 Reporting of cancer.

Rule 1. (1) On and after May 1, 1947, every physician, dentist, hospital superintendent, and clinic director who has knowledge of a case of cancer shall, within 10 days, report the same to the Michigan department of health on a form provided by said department. The report shall contain the name and address of the patient and either the name and address of the physician, or of the dentist, or of the hospital superintendent and hospital, or of the clinic director and clinic, and such other data as may be required.

(2) All such reports and records of the Michigan department of health pertaining to cancer are hereby declared to be confidential.
