PART 90. PERMIT-REQUIRED CONFINED SPACES

R 408.19001 Scope.

Rule 9001. (1) These rules establish minimum requirements for the practices and procedures to protect employees from the hazards associated with entry into permit-required confined spaces.

- (2) The provisions of these rules shall be applied unless they conflict with specific requirements for confined space entry in any other general industry standard.
- (3) These rules do not apply to agriculture, construction, or to shipyard employment.
