SIZE CLASSIFICATION RULES

(By authority conferred on the liquor control commission by section 3 of the Initiated Law of 1976, being S445.573 of the Michigan Compiled Laws)

R 445.1 Definitions.

Rule 1. (1) As used in these rules "act" means the Initiated Law of 1976, being S445.571 et seq. of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

(2) The terms defined in the act have the same meaning when used in these rules, unless otherwise indicated.

R 445.3 Size classifications.

Rule 3. (1) The commission may certify beverage containers for beverages other than beer, ale, or other malt drink of whatever alcoholic content.

(2) The commission may certify beverage containers in 1 of the following size classifications; 7 oz.; 12 oz.; 16 oz.; 32 oz.; 64 oz.; 128 oz.; 2 liters.

(3) Additional size classifications may be certified if the beverage container is in compliance with section 2(7) and section 3(2), (3), and (4) of the act.
