PETITION REQUESTING PROMULGATION, AMENDMENT, OR RESCISSION OF RULES

(By authority of Act No. 197 of the Public Acts of 1952, as amended, being S24.101 et seq. of the Michigan Compiled Laws)

R 501.351 Statement of facts and law.

Rule 1. Said petition shall state the facts and law upon which the petitioner relies in seeking promulgation, amendment, or rescission of any rule.

R 501.352 Writing requirement.

Rule 2. Said petition shall be presented in writing to the department of insurance 30 days prior to a decision in the matter.

R 501.353 Disposition of petition by decision.

Rule 3. The department of insurance shall consider the petition and dispose thereof by submitting in writing to the petitioner and his attorney of record, the department's decision and reasons therefor.

R 501.354 Request for hearing.

Rule 4. In the event said ruling on the petition is contrary to the request of the petitioner, the petitioner shall have 30 days during which time he may request a hearing before the department of insurance in accordance with the rules previously filed with the secretary of state on December 18, 1953, pursuant to Act No. 197 of the Public Acts of 1952.
